- I) Deposits and Registrations: Tour Payments are banked into Vintage Sports and Leisure Ltd client account at the National Bank of New Zealand Ltd. Vintage Sport and Leisure is a fully bonded member of the Travel Agents Association of New Zealand (TAANZ).
